- Complete the **Departure** and **Destination CPH** box by entering in the form of CC/PPP/HHHH

- ① Clicking on the **Select** option, highlighted by the red box, opens the **Holding Quick Select** window. This lists *Frequently used, Abattoir* or *Mart* CPHs. By selecting the correct holding from a list, the CPH will then be prepopulated into the Departure or Destination box on the movement document.






