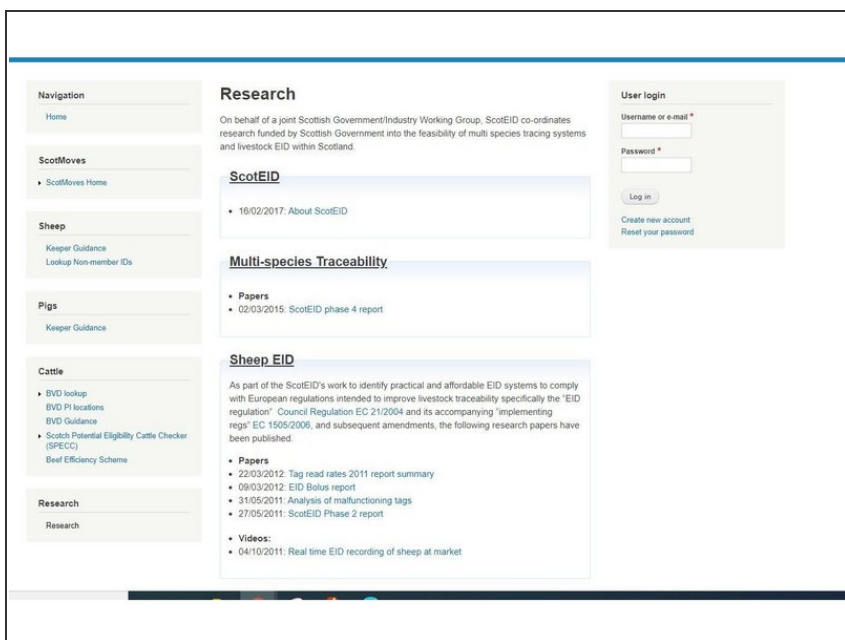


Step 1 — ScotEID Research
