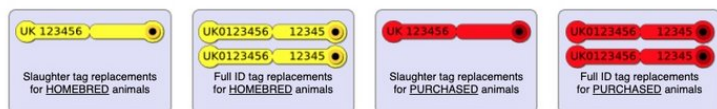
- Underneath the Sheep header, click on Visually Record Data

Step 2 — Visually Record Data - Death

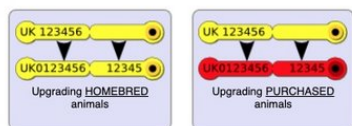
